

# Jaybird Georgia Oak

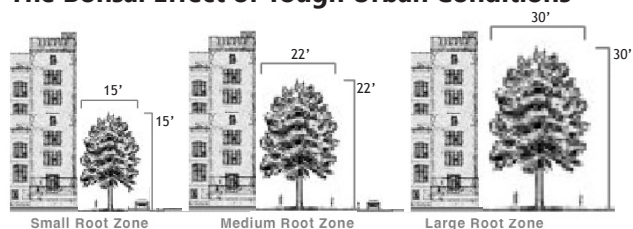
*Quercus georgiana* 'Jaybird'

Native small to medium tree - own root. Discovered by Steve Sanchez from a group of seedlings at Select Trees, the Jaybird Georgia Oak is a handsome, densely branched tree that is perfect for tight spaces, planters, or as park tree. Leaves drop clean in fall.
