Ulmus americana 'Princeton'

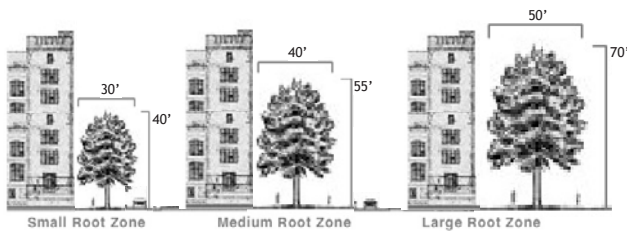

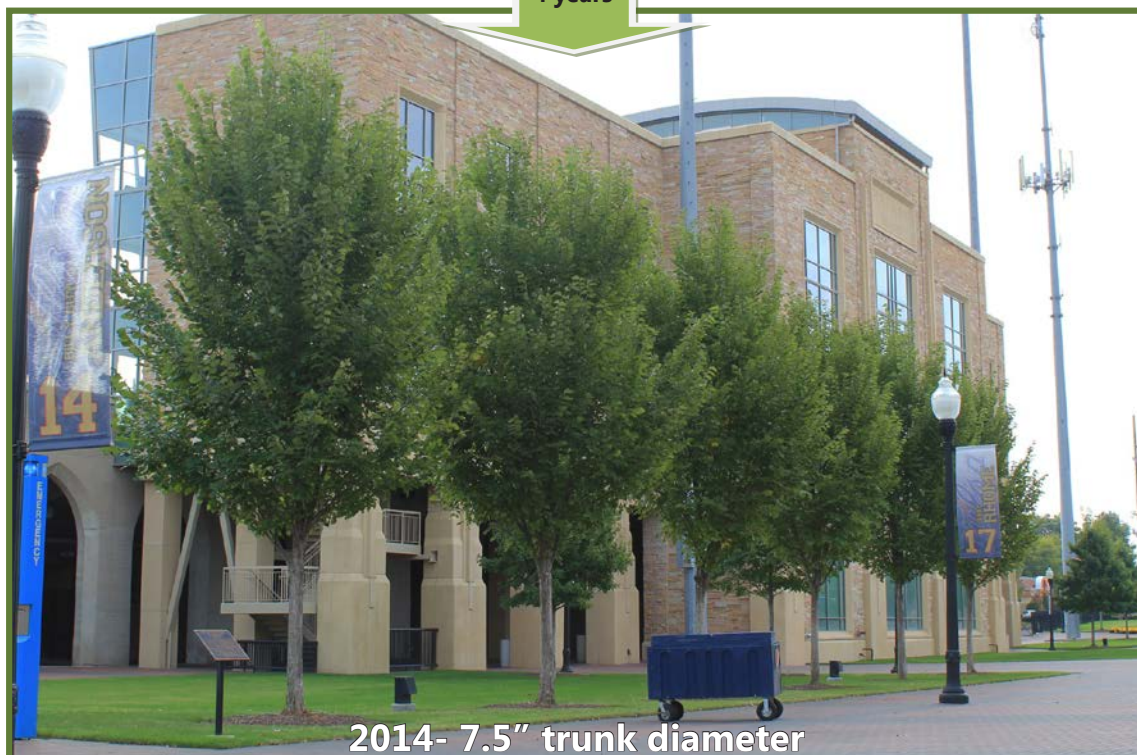
